### TWINKLE DANCE PROGRAM (Ages 3 - 5)

**The Best of Both Worlds** - This exciting pre-school dance program introduces a fun curriculum while maintaining the high standards of excellent training BC is known for. While fostering a love of dance, our youngest dancers will be prepared in proper technique and coordination so they may soar when they enter singular genre classes at age 6.

#### Twinkle Ballet (Ages 3 & 4)

3 & 4 year olds take this class which is 45 minutes long. Even if your dancer is already 4 ½ years old, we recommend that all first year Twinkle Dancers start with Twinkle Ballet to prepare them for Twinkle Ballet and Tap.

Ballet and Tap shoes will be the responsibility of the parent. Required shoes are Black tap shoes - must have Velcro closures to aid in the quick change of shoes during class. Ballet shoes are to be tight-fitting and Capezio or Bloch leather with bows double knotted and tucked in. These are available at our dancewear store for your convenience and may be purchased at Open House.

Boys will need to purchase their own dance clothes and shoes, therefore, will not be charged the \$75 registration fee. They will receive a dance bag designed for our boys and an invitation to the Nutcracker Party! Boys will need:

If they are in the Twinkle Ballet and Tap class, they will also need boy's black tap shoes.

### Pre-Professional Supplement (Pre Pros)

Pre Pro is a special group of dedicated dancers who come together each Friday for strengthening, stretching and to work specifically on skills needed for center work. It is for levels 3, Teen Ballet, 4, 5. There is no audition required for Pre Pro but dancers must take a minimum of two ballet classes per week to be a part of Pre Pro. Because of the amount of improvement Pre Pro make during the year, the T/Th Ballet 3 class is reserved for those in Pre Pro. This class teaches proper etiquette and professionalism and provides performance opportunities besides the annual recital. Pre Pro dancers may audition for LBT productions when children's roles are needed. A special Pre Pro leotard, skirt and a warmup is required as well as light pink canvas ballet slippers. Boys have a required shirt, warmup jacket, black tights & black shoes. Fittings will take place on the first day of class.

This program is by audition or invitation. It was developed to meet the needs of the serious student who may possibly choose a career in the field of dance or pursue a college dance degree. Students who desire only 2 or 3 classes a week should take classes in our excellent Open Program. Students in any Advanced Class must abide by an additional set of policies. A parent and dancer are to schedule a meeting with the director if this will be your first year in an Advanced class (with the exception of Advanced Tap) to review these policies. Advanced adults may enroll in these classes with permission of an instructor.

### Please Note:

In case of inclement weather, we follow the lead of L.I.S.D. and send registered students an email, as well as post on our Ballet Conservatory FACEBOOK PAGE and INSTAGRAM PAGE. FOLLOW US for the latest studio news and photos. As with any other closure or absence, students are allowed to makeup classes within 2 months of the absence, but must be completed during the semester of the absence. Makeups may not carry over to a new semester.

## ADVANCED PROGRAM & COMPANY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Required days for Advanced Ballet are M/Tu/Th/Sat. Wed and Fri classes are optional but highly recommended.
2. Advanced Modern and Advanced Jazz students are required to take at least one ballet class.
3. Attendance must be limited to 3 absences a semester in order to remain in an Advanced class and/or recital dance or one of our dance companies.
4. All Adv Ballet and Jazz students, LBT, LBT2 are required to take a minimum of 3 weeks of our 5-week BC Summer Workshop, or an approved out of town Intensive. IDC – See summer requirements in your contract.

**Note:** Keep in mind that in order to be successful in an Advanced Ballet Program, 5 to 6 days a week of training is the universal standard. It is important to study other styles of dance in order to achieve the versatility necessary for a career in dance these days. Training in classical ballet is vital to your success, even for those who are more interested in jazz, contemporary or other genres. Dancers are encouraged to stretch, condition and cross-train to avoid injury.

### LBT and LBT 2 minimum requirements:

Four ballet classes each week; 1 contemporary/modern class; and 1 Jazz class. Pre Pro does fulfill the ballet requirement, but pointe/pre-pointe classes do not. Tap and other dance forms are not required but highly recommended for musicality, coordination and versatility.

### IDC minimum requirements:

Juniors – 2 Ballet, 1 Jazz and 1 Tap  
Intermediates- 2 Ballet, 1 Jazz, 1 Tap. Contemporary/Modern not required but highly recommended.  
Seniors – 3 Ballet, 1 Jazz, 1 Tap, Contemporary/Modern  
Pre Pro does fulfill the ballet requirement, but pointe/pre-pointe classes do not. Company dancers are encouraged to take other dance forms such as hip hop and musical theater as IDC performs these styles of dance.

### Nutcracker Audition and Rehearsals:

LBT holds open auditions for all area ballet students ages 5 & up for the annual production of "The Nutcracker." One Audition ONLY is held Saturday, September 7<sup>th</sup>. If cast, rehearsals for children's roles are held Saturday afternoons beginning late September. Pointe roles and lead roles also rehearse on Tuesday and Thursday during LBT times. There are mandatory theater rehearsals held during Thanksgiving Week, Nov. 24-27. Nutcracker Dress Rehearsal and Performances are Nov. 29-Dec 1.

### Communication:

We communicate through our "Five Pointes" email every Monday with studio news and important information. Please make sure we have your correct email in Jackrabbit and that you receive an email each Monday. Please let us know if you wish to add additional emails to the "Five Pointes." It is always nice if the dancer receives the email as well so they are aware of Theme Weeks, auditions, etc.

## TUITION & IMPORTANT INFO

Tuition is charged per person and is non-refundable. A full month's tuition is charged for all months, including those with 5 weeks, holidays or missed classes. Students are allowed to makeup classes within 2 months of the absence but must be completed during the semester of the absence. Makeups may not carry over to a new semester. Every student will pay a non-refundable \$60 registration fee each fall or upon initial registration. **Twinkle Dance Program Tuition and Registration Fee listed on page 1 of this schedule.** Family discount is 10% when a minimum of 4 combined classes are taken. Boy discount is 25%. Only one discount per family may be used. See our website for dress code requirements for all our students.

### BY-THE-CLASS RATE - \$20 per class

**PROFESSIONAL RATE - \$15 per class** – Director must approve. No pro rate is given for Mr. Jordan's classes or Master Classes.

**ADULT CLASS CARD AVAILABLE** – For our adults busy schedules, we offer a Class Card with a discount on the by the class rate. Parents or Adult siblings of an enrolled student receive a more substantial discount on their class card. Please inquire or see our website.

**TUITION for Regular Classes** Semester Tuition reflects a 5% discount if paid in advance. A half month is charged for August. Fall semester runs Aug. 18 thru January. Spring runs from Feb. 1 thru Recital. Spring tuition may be adjusted slightly once we confirm Recital dates!

### RECITAL FEES AND COSTUME PAYMENTS:

Students enrolled by Jan. 5<sup>th</sup> may participate in an exciting annual recital the first weekend in June. A recital agreement will be emailed and must be returned by Nov 1. There is a RECITAL FEE OF \$90. (Family Max is 2 recital fees) and is due March 1<sup>st</sup>. Because of our recital fee, there is no need to purchase tickets for the performances.

### COSTUME COSTS:

All Twinkle Dancers - Only one costume needed.

Twinkle Ballet Only - \$70

Twinkle Ballet and Tap - \$80

Ages 6 to 11 - \$85 per dance form studied.

Ages 12 and up and All Advanced - \$95 per dance form

We start collecting for recital costumes in October to guarantee costumes are delivered by recital. A costume is purchased for each dance form studied. Costume payments are based on age. Those who have several costumes may pay for 2 costumes per month. Please speak to our office manager if you wish to work out a payment plan. If you decide you cannot participate, please notify us by returning the recital agreement by Nov 1<sup>st</sup>, and we will not order costumes for your dancer and refund any costume payments made. **Once costumes are actually ordered in early December, no refunds will be given.**
